- 3. Approval of Minutes of October 27 meeting:** Motioned by Victor seconded by Loreigh
- 4. Principal's report:** School is going to continue monitoring attendance for students (e-mail coming this Wednesday from ASDW) but the primary goal for the SIP is Numeracy. Core Leadership Team is meeting approximately once a month to monitor the areas of the school that need improvement. Allows for shared leadership within the school/teaching community. Provincial Assessments, Report Card Data, Teacher observations led the Core team to decide that confidence in Numeracy needs to be a priority.
 - Attendance is going to be monitored and teachers will call home after 3 missed days of school to see if it is a problematic or non-problematic absences.**
 - 7Prime kids are working in Flexible grouping twice a week.
 - 8Prime kids are working in Flexible grouping based on the teachers strengths in order to build confidence in areas that students needs growth. The expectation is for academic

growth and growth in confidence implementing math skills through language, numeracy, and STEAM.

-8FI Teams are making passion projects using numeracy and linking them to cross curricular outcomes.

-7FI is also doing flex grouping, then an Escape Room and Amazing Race final assessment

-6FI is working on vocabulary, then Stats and Probability

-6EP working on key terms and synonyms during AIT

-Specialists are working on using statistics and fractions to relate numeracy to their daily lives so students see the practical uses of numeracy in their daily life.

-Thursday Lunch Math Group when UNB Professor is available for enrichment programs

-Gift Card Campaign is starting soon to support students and families in the area.

6. Other business:

- a. New School Planning Update: Another meeting on Thursday (#5) about Doak Road/Lincoln area. Opinions were given to try and implement in design, but there has been push back when it has been advised by PSSC and Admin and it has been disregarded.
