-Acquiring land for Forest Hill/Liverpool new school location (approximately #4 priority with DEC)

-George Street middle school land has not been acquired

-Absenteeism/Chronic Absenteeism Policy is supposed to be implemented by the end of September to add to homeroom teachers workload after 3 days of absence, then ESS will get involved, then administration, then additional supports will be called in. District will not be providing further support to the school to do this.
